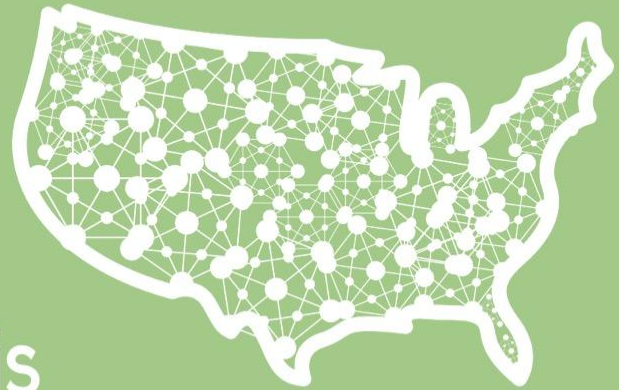
# Problem

We're stuck in **social bubbles** that lead to **communication gaps** and **division**.



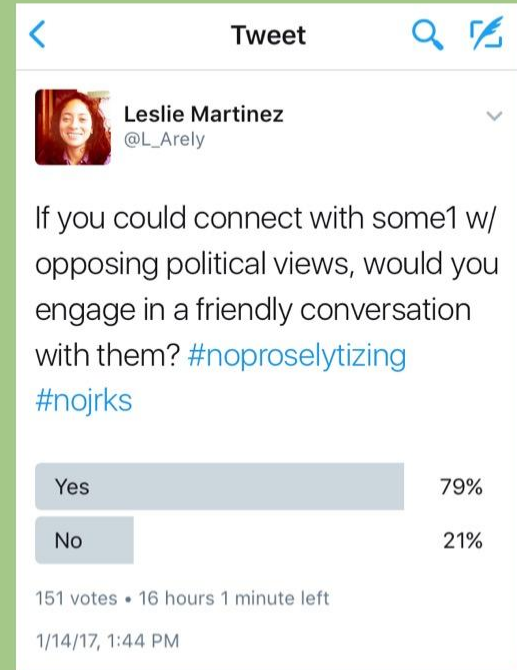
# Solution

79% of 151 people surveyed would engage in **friendly conversation** with someone with **opposing** political views.



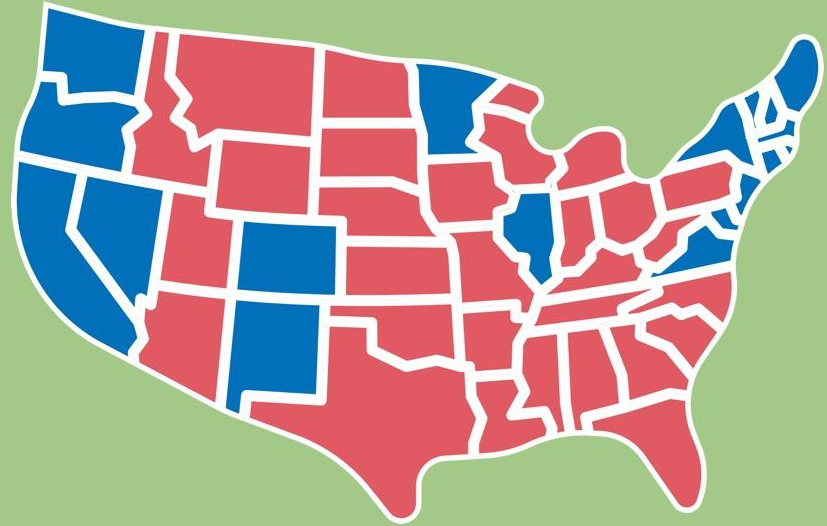

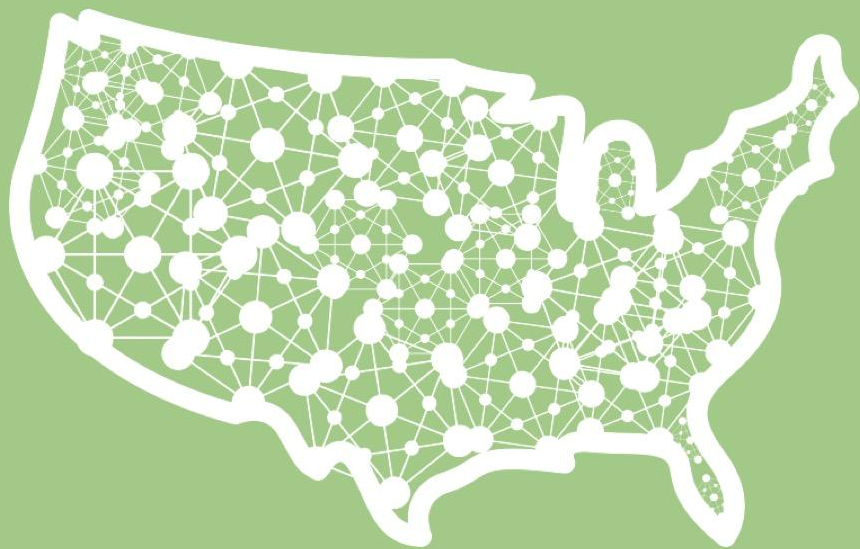
